

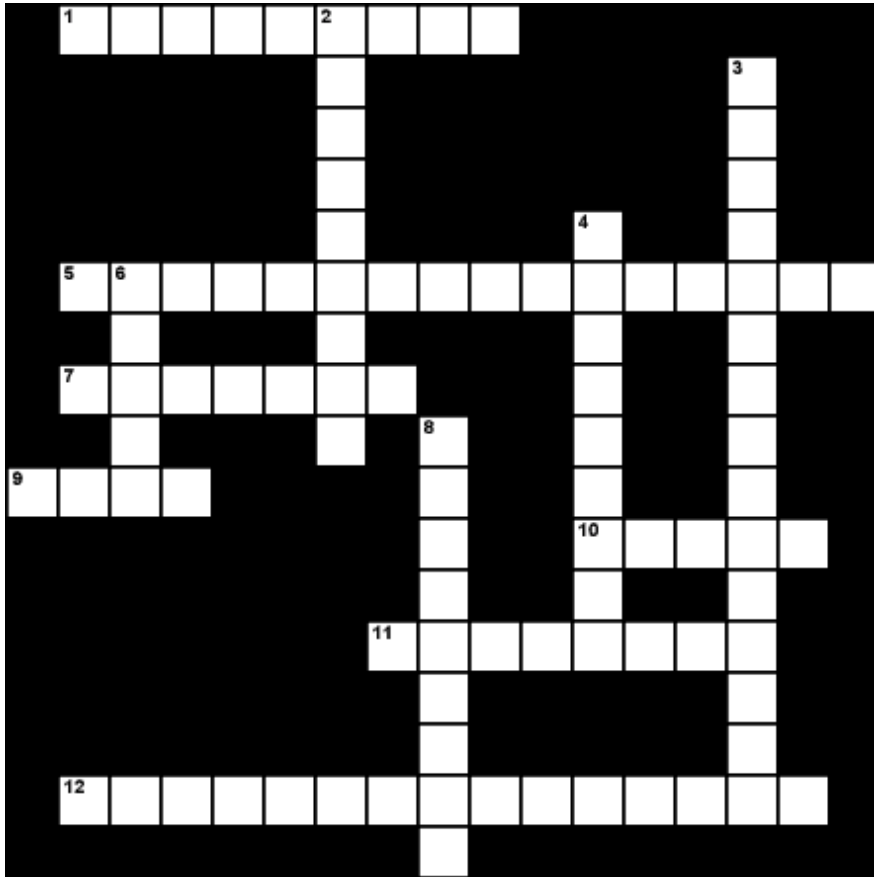


These are exercises on words related to the United Nations and the Security Council. This worksheet goes well with the Upper Intermediate lesson, the **Security Council**.

Complete this crossword puzzle about the Security Council and the United Nations by using the clues listed.

2. Vocabulary Pair work

3. Vocabulary Work

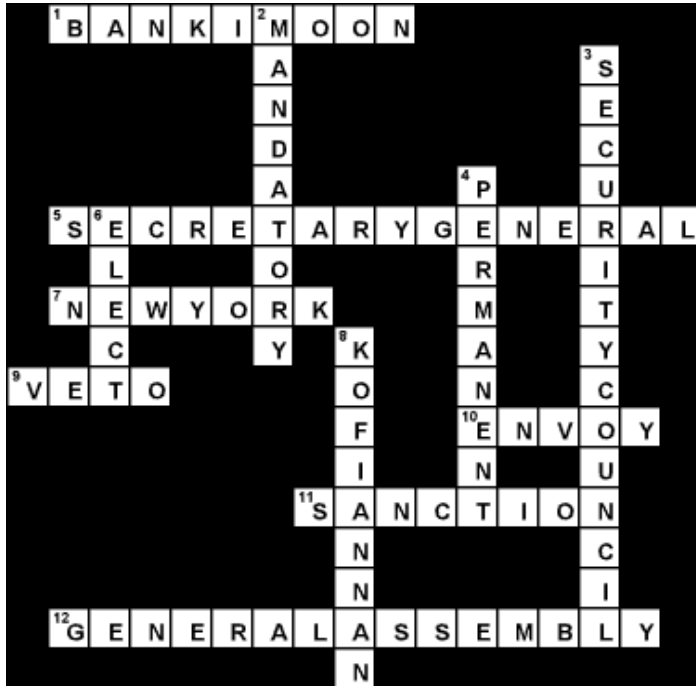
Discovered any new words doing these exercises?

Add them and their meanings to your vocabulary notebook.

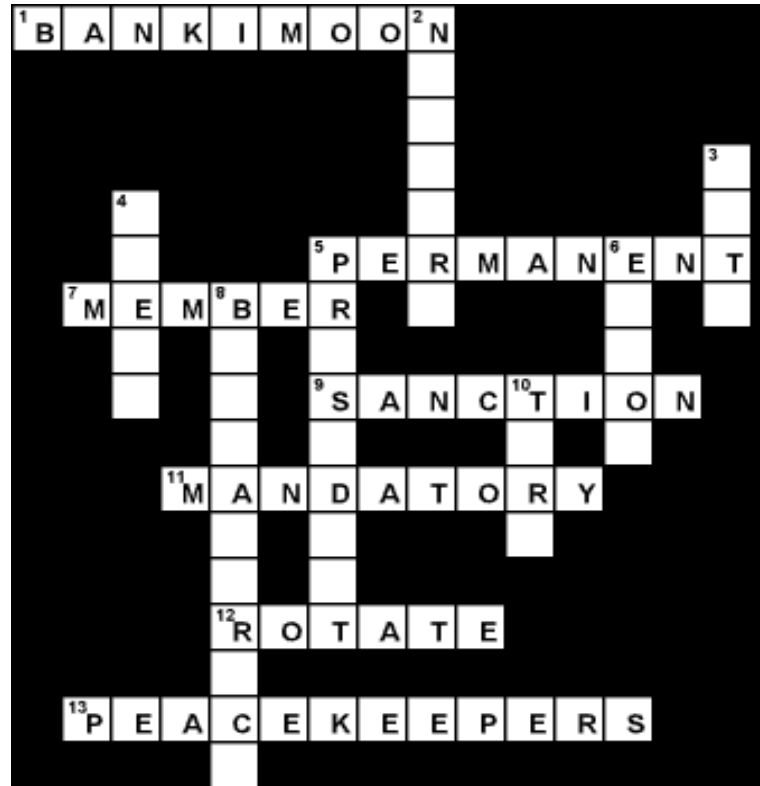

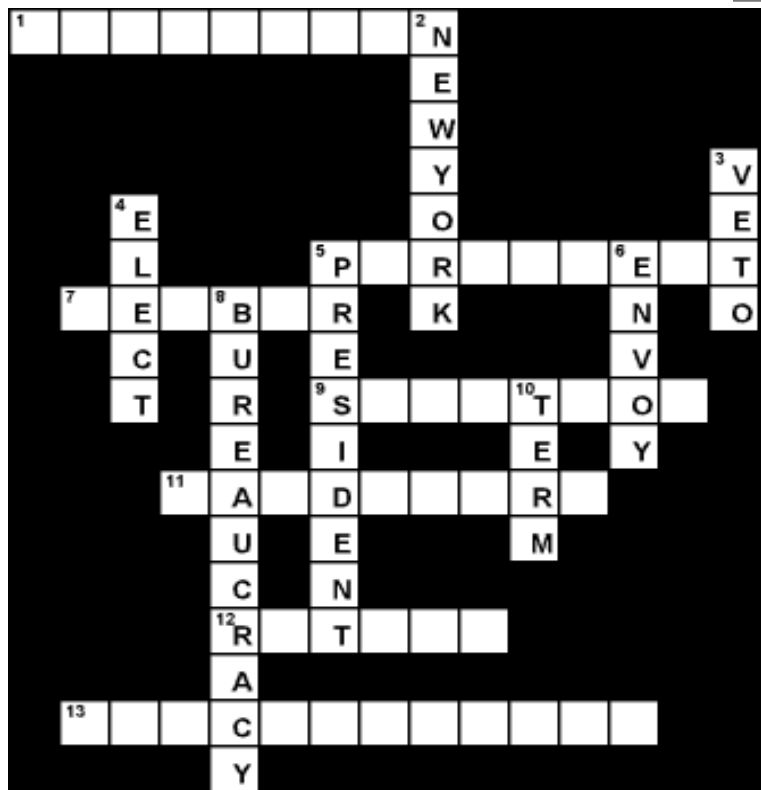


Pair Crossword for Student B
